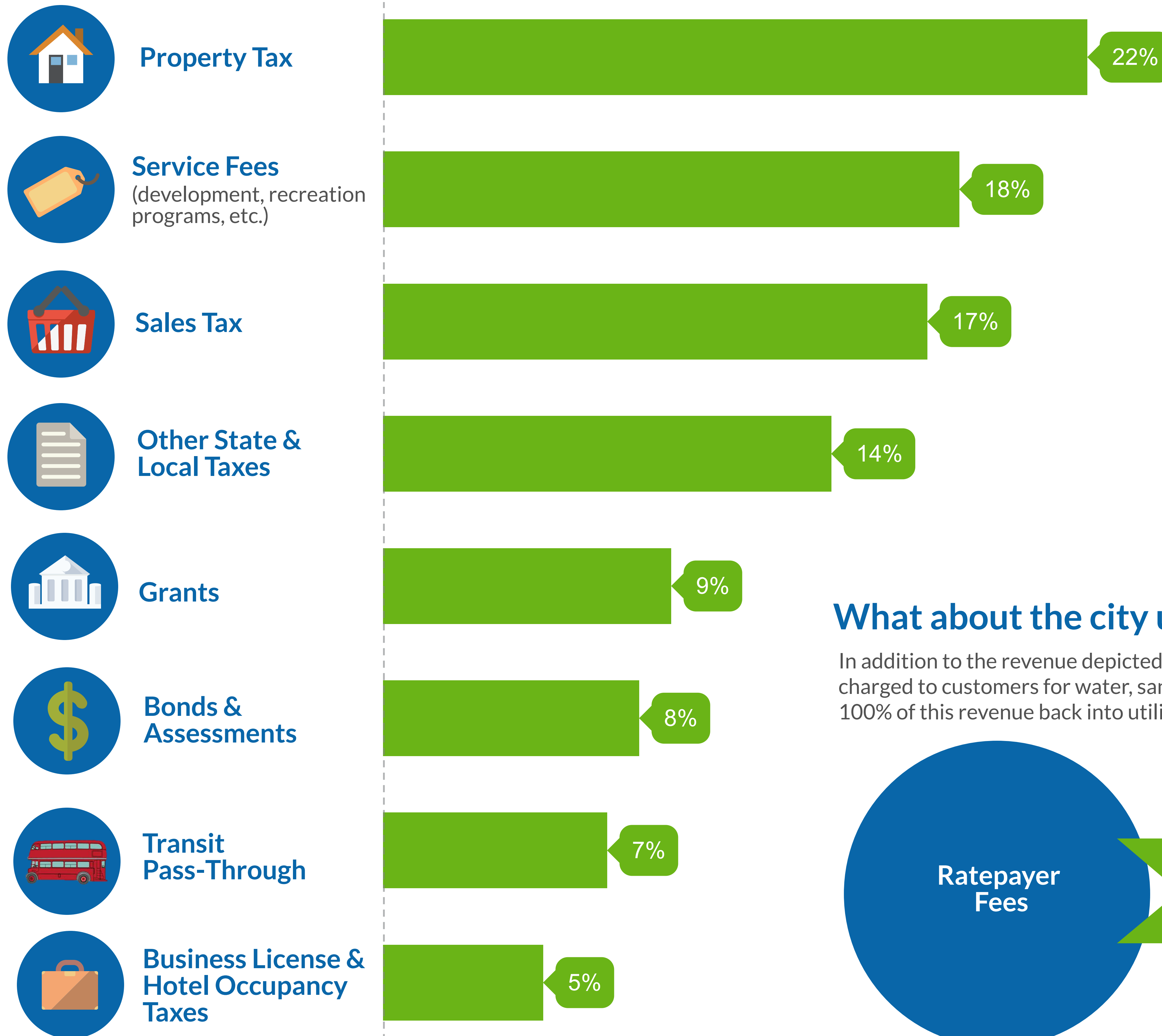


A look at the City's major revenue sources.

The graph below features the City's major revenue sources, excluding utility ratepayer revenue.



Did you know?

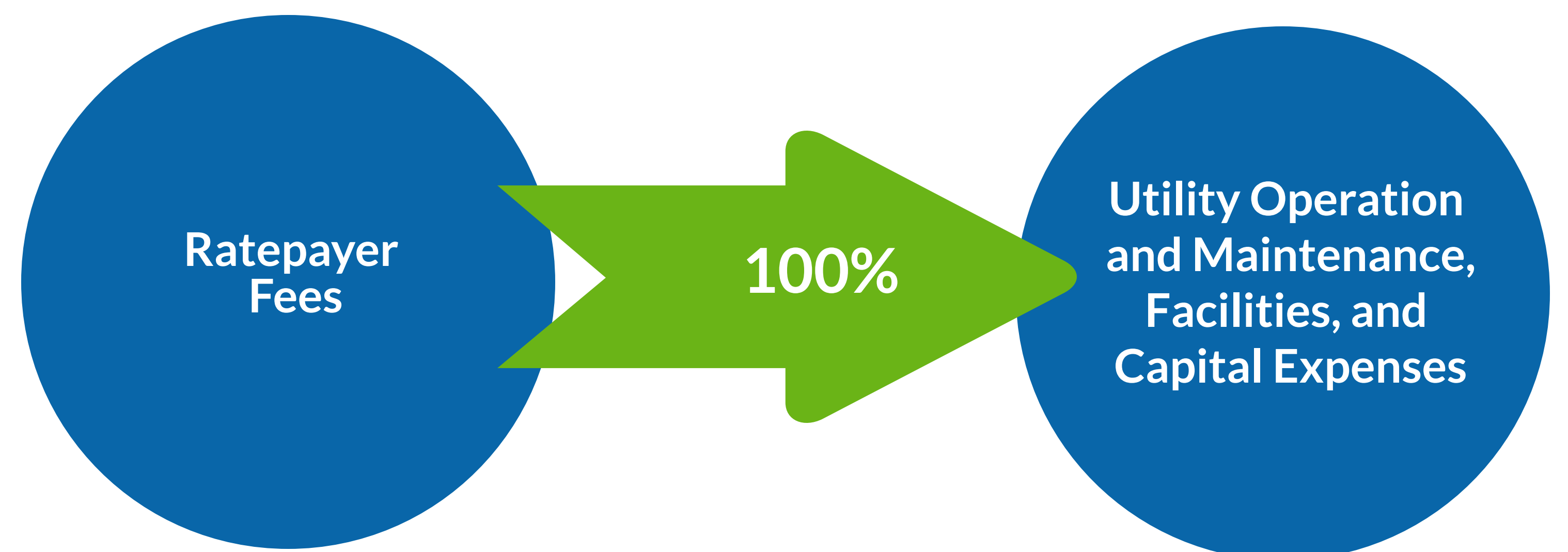
- 1** The City receives approximately 18% of property tax revenue from Davis properties.

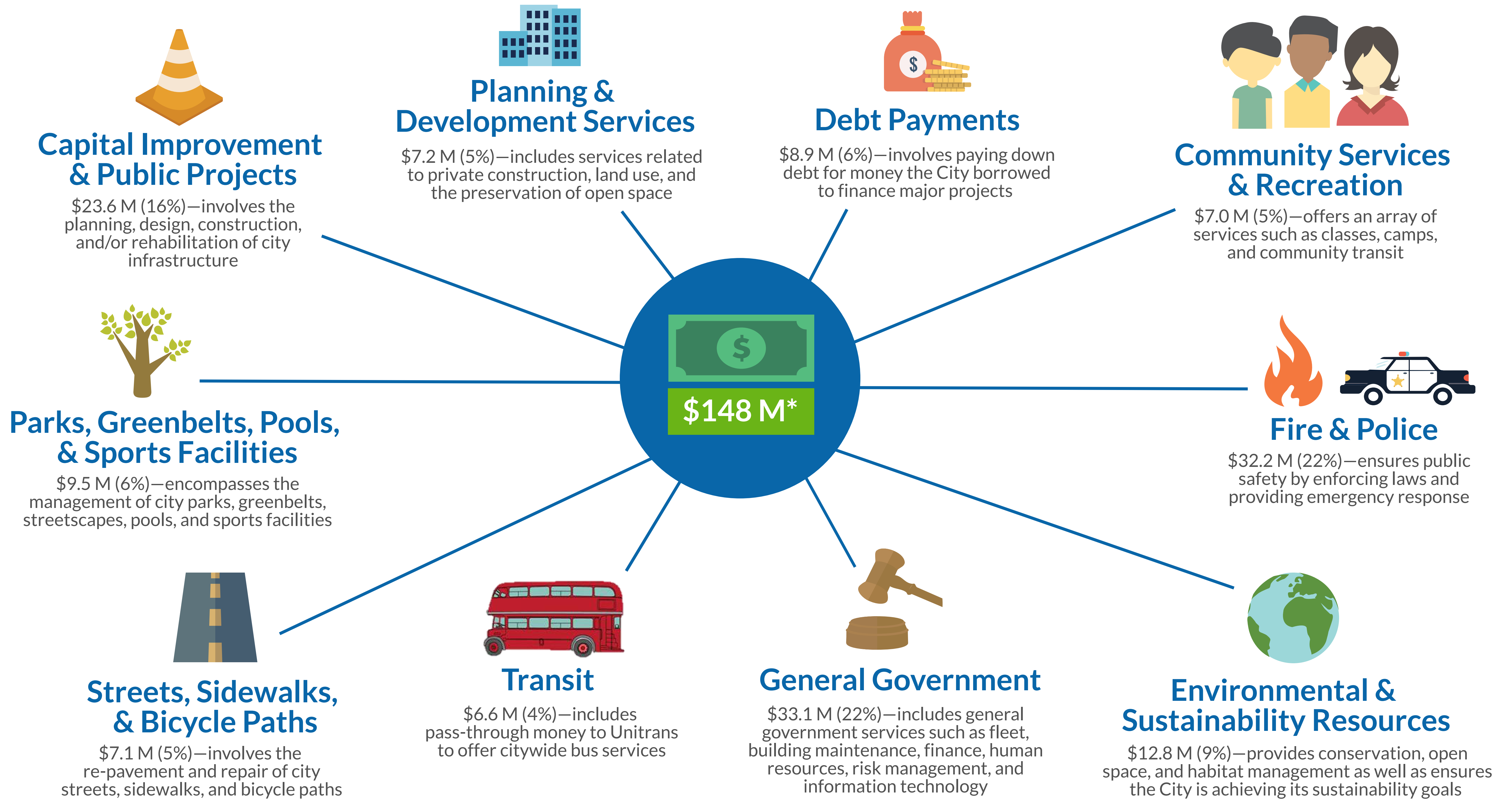
While the exact percentage differs by neighborhood, the citywide average is 18%. Most of the remaining 82% goes to Yolo County and the Davis Joint Unified School District.
- 2** When you make a purchase, the City receives 1/4 of the sales tax charged.

The remaining 3/4 of the 8.25% goes to Yolo County and the State.
- 3** Unlike other taxes, the City keeps 100% of the revenue generated by city-levied tax measures.

What about the city utility bill I pay each month?

In addition to the revenue depicted in the graph, the City receives ratepayer revenue from fees charged to customers for water, sanitation, sewer, and storm drain services. The City reinvests 100% of this revenue back into utility operation and maintenance, facilities, and capital expenses.
