Davis Chamber Announces Support for DiSC 2022

Davis, Calif. – The Davis Chamber of Commerce today announced that it is supporting the updated Davis Innovation & Sustainability Campus, now known as DiSC 2022, and will play an active role in helping to secure City and voter approval for the plan.

The new DiSC 2022 plan being proposed by Ramco Enterprises and The Buzz Oates Group of Companies is about half as large as the proposal that appeared on the November 2020 ballot. It includes laboratory, R&D and advanced manufacturing facilities, homes designed to appeal to innovation center employees, affordable housing, a hotel, and parks.

“DiSC 2022 will provide huge economic and community benefits to Davis. We’re excited to support it, and we’re fully committed to helping educate our members, residents and voters about why it’s so important to move the plan forward,” said Cory Koehler, executive director of the Davis Chamber.

DiSC 2022 currently is under review by several City commissions before it goes to the City Council early next year for proposed approval to put the plan before Davis voters on the June 2022 ballot.
